HOME LEARNING

Home-learning will consist of: reading for ten minutes per day, logging onto 'Numbots' for ten minutes per day and completing the reading challenges found in the back of the reading record book. On Mondays, children will receive spellings. These are to be practiced each day and the children will be tested on the following Friday.

READING BOOKS

Children will receive 2 x reading books per week that are suitable for their ability.

They will be given new reading books on Fridays and will be expected to hand it in on the following Wednesday.

Please listen to your child read for 10 minutes per night and comment/sign the reading record once a week.

Children will also choose a library book during the Year One Library session each week. This may not be suitable for their reading ability but for the child to enjoy and read for pleasure.

HOME TIME ARRANGEMENTS
