READING BOOKS

Home reading books will be changed once a week by a member of the Year 3 team. Children are expected to bring their reading books and filled-in reading records **every Wednesday** so that staff can check records and prepare new reading books to go **home on a Friday**.

Each time your child brings in their reading record with a comment in it, they will receive a raffle ticket which will enter them into a weekly draw for a small prize.

HOME LEARNING

Reading - Little and often, at least 10 minutes each day.

Maths—TT Rock Stars. Children should be playing this educational game at home regularly—we expect at least 20 minutes completed weekly. We will check this on a Wednesday and reward appropriately.

Spellings—Spellings will be given out on fortnightly on Fridays and the children will be tested at the end of the fortnight.

TUCK/SNACK

In Year 3, children are no longer provided with milk and fruit and our tuck shop will not be available this year.

Please make sure your child comes to school with a **healthy snack** that they can eat at play time.
