HOME LEARNING

Reading - to build your child's reading miles and fluency, short bursts of daily reading is most effective. Reading books are given out on Fridays and returned on Wednesdays. We recommend at least 10 minutes of daily reading.

Spelling— children will bring home a sheet of common exception words to learn by the time they reach the end of the year. Spelling patterns are taught in class and KS2 are expected to practise these through their Spelling Shed account for at least 20 minutes per week. Rather than weekly tests, we assess the children's spelling through their daily writing.

Handwriting - all children can practise their letter formation using their Letter Join log in details. We recommend this for at least 10 minutes a week.

Times Tables - to ensure that children are well-prepared for their MTC check in the summer term, we recommend at least 20 minutes of extra practice on Times Table Rockstars each week, using Soundcheck or Studio.

Each half-term, children will be given the opportunity to complete a project based around one of our foundation subjects.

HEALTHY SCHOOL

Any snacks eaten at break time should be healthy with **no nuts**. Children should fill their bottles with water only.

TEACHING
