

READING BOOKS

Reading books and reading records are expected to be in school every Wednesday whether they have completed the book or not. On this day, children will change their reading books from the colour-coded selection in the classroom,

Please encourage your child to read at home daily and keep their reading records up to date. Parents and teachers will be writing in reading records on a regular basis therefore it is essential that they are in school.

Children will be able to take home their new or existing reading book with their reading record on a Friday for it to be due back to be checked the following Wednesday.

HOME LEARNING

Homework will work a little differently this year. Your child will be given a hard copy of their spellings to practice at home and will be expected to read and use Times Table Rockstars 20 minutes per evening - this will be monitored.

PE

PE will be taught on Wednesdays this term by your child's class teacher. Pupils need a white t-shirt, blue shorts and black pumps to change in to in school. It is recommended that PE kit is taken home on the day of PE to be washed and brought back in to school the next day as the day PE is taught on could change at short notice. In colder weather jogging bottoms, tracksuit top and trainers are needed.
