HOME LEARNING

Spelling— children will bring home a sheet of common exception words to learn by the time they reach the end of the year/phase. Spelling patterns are taught in class and KS2 are expected to practise these through their Spelling Shed account. Rather than weekly tests, we assess the children's spelling through their daily writing.

Handwriting - all children can practise their letter formation using their Letter Join log in details. We recommend this for at least 10 minutes a week.

Reading books -To build your child's reading miles and fluency, short bursts of daily reading is most effective. Reading books are given out on Fridays and returned on Wednesdays.

Maths - Please use Times Table Rock Stars for at least 20 minutes per week. This will be checked by your child's teacher weekly.

HEALTHY SCHOOL

Any snacks eaten at break time should be healthy with **no nuts**. Children should fill their bottles with water only.

WELCOME TO YEAR 5

We hope the following information will help you and your child settle quickly into their new year group.

TEACHING

Pupils will be taught in two teams whilst they are in Year 5 for all National Curriculum subjects.

START AND END TIMES

The school gates will open at 8.45am and remain open until 8.55am.

Children will need to be collected promptly at 3:15pm from the KS2 playground.

In year 5, it is possible for your child to walk home by themselves. If you would like this to happen, please send a letter or email of consent to the main school office or to your child's teacher.

PE

PE will be taught on a **Thursday** this term by your child's class teacher. Pupils need a white t-shirt, navy shorts and black pumps to change in to in school. It is recommended that PE kit is taken home on the day of PE to be washed and brought back in to school the next day as the day PE is taught on could change at short notice. In colder weather, plain jogging bottoms and plain black trainers are needed. We ask that children do not wear designer labels or football kits. In Y5, girls and boys change separately.

LEARNING JOURNEY

Termly assessments in reading, writing, maths, spelling, punctuation and grammar are used to inform both teaching and learning.

UNIFORM

All children are expected to be in the correct uniform at all times: Grey skirt or trousers, white or pale blue t-shirt, white plain shirt, navy sweatshirt with logo (V-neck or round neck) and black shoes with no heel. – More information is available on our website.
