At Birmingham Magistrates Court on 16 December 2015 Re: Prosecution of parents/ carers, Education Act 1996 Section 444 a case was heard.

After hearing the circumstances of the case the Magistrates imposed a fine of £40, a victim surcharge of £20 and criminal court charge of £150; a total of £210 per parent. The Court took into consideration the early guilty plea and the financial circumstances; this is reflected in the fine.
