Rewarding Attendance at New Hall

Did you know that each week the Team that has the best attendance earns £1? The children then decide together whether to save their money and buy something special at the end of the year or to spend it on something smaller such as sweets. Children can also earn individual prizes. At the end of each term, all children who have 100% attendance get a special attendance certificate and can choose a prize to take home. Last year these included: coloring books, soft toys, skipping ropes, bats and balls and lots more.

Finally, if your child achieves 100% attendance for the whole year, they are invited to enjoy a special trip in July, which is completely free of charge. Last year 32 children went to Conkers Outdoor Activity Centre and enjoyed a ranger led Gruffalo Trail and Bushcraft Activities.

All they have to do is come to school every day!

New Parents to Parentmail

To communicate with our parents either via text or email we use a system called Parentmail. Now your child has started at New Hall, with your permission we have added you to Parentmail. How do you get started?

By now you should have received a text from Parentmail, simply follow the instructions in the message.

Once registered, if you have an Android or Apple smartphone, we highly recommend you download the Parentmail App.

Lots of benefits for downloading the App:

- Free to download
- Parents can notify the school of their child/ren absence
- If all parents use the App we can stop sending text messages completely and put the money spent to better use

If parents are not receiving communications from New Hall, maybe check we have the right mobile number and email address. Once registered on Parentmail you can update your own personal details on there and it will automatically update our Parentmail at school.
