Attendance

As many of you are aware it is really important that your child attends school everyday as it will enable them to reach their full potential educationally and also make important social relationships. We monitor attendance very carefully at New Hall and work closely with CSAWS (Central School Attendance and Welfare Service) to support families to improve attendance. As you may have seen in the news recently, if a child fails to attend school regularly, it is seen by the courts as neglect and this can lead to fines, tagging of individuals and even imprisonment. Unfortunately, we sometimes have to take further action when a child fails to attend our school and this has recently resulted in a family at New Hall receiving a fine of £609. Please ensure your child comes to school everyday to avoid this action being taken against you.

Nursery

There has been an increasing number of parents collecting their children late from Nursery. Can we remind you nursery finishes at 11.45am and children need to be collected at 11.45am.

The nursery setting area is used for other activities so prompt collection is very important.
