# <u>Safer Internet Day</u>

Safer Internet Day 2018 was celebrated globally on **Tuesday 6th February 2018** with the slogan "Create, Connect and Share Respect: A better internet starts with you". Children around the country partook in lessons and activities to highlight the positive use of technology and help create a better and safer online community. Each child at New Hall also completed a digital footprint design to represent how they stay safe online.

# New Hall's top 3 tips for staying safe online:

When at home, keep devices/ computers in a family friendly room. This allows parents/ guardians to monitor who children are playing with and the content being accessed.

Use parental controls- all consoles as well as most tablet devices allow a maximum PEGI rating to be set. Taking regular breaks online can also be set by parental timers.

Talk to your child- Connect with your child by asking them to share with you their favourite things to online, as well as highlighting the potential risks. Ensure they are aware of what to do if they see something inappropriate or makes them feel uncomfortable or unsure. Also allow them to understand that they could be reported if they break the rules.
