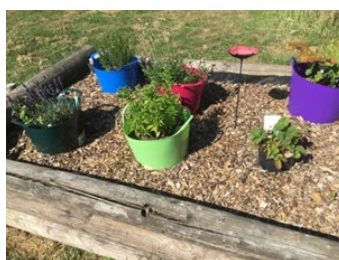
Forest School
