Attendance Policy

Please note the following addition to our Attendance Policy -

Leave in term time (holiday requests) may now be referred to the legal team to proceed with a Leave in Term Time (Penalty Notice)'. Further guidance is available on the website: https:// www.birmingham.gov.uk/schoolattendance. This process enables the Local Authority to issue a penalty notice to a parent/carer for removing their child from school for an unauthorised leave of absence in term time, such as taking their child on two weeks unauthorised leave (such as a holiday) in term time with no previous unauthorised absence. Parents may also be issued with a penalty notice for taking their children out of school for a week of unauthorised leave as long as there are at least 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence over the previous 12 calendar months.

Parking and Verbal Abuse

Unfortunately, even though we have only been back at school for a week or so we have already had neighbours phoning us with reports of inconsiderate parking and verbal abuse by parents.

We always strive to have good relationships with our neighbours, and fully appreciate that, like all schools, parking is an ongoing issue at pick up and drop off time in particular for parents. We will continue to support any neighbours who go to the police to report unacceptable behaviour by our parents. Whilst fully appreciating that the vast majority of our parents are considerate and polite, there does continue to be a core group who believe that general rules about common courtesy don't apply to them. Please give consideration to others by not smoking, swearing or parking over drives at all times.

Please be aware of what message you are giving your children if you do this.
