#### Safety at hometime.

For the safety of all, children will only be dismissed at the end of the day once the teacher has SEEN who is picking them up. As a result, please make yourself known to your child's teacher by being in a visible spot and acknowledging that you are there. If you do need to have a brief conversation with the teacher then please do wait until the class have been dismissed, so that you are not delaying other parents.

#### End of day arrangements for children

#### being picked up late.

We have had an increasing number of children regularly being picked up late, often this is the same children day in, day out. As a reminder to all, school finishes at **3pm**. On rare occasions parents may be delayed, and we ask that you please telephone the school to make us aware, so that suitable care can be arranged for your child. Being informed that parents 'went to the shops' or 'fell asleep' are not considered justifiable excuses.

As you can appreciate school does not finish at 3pm for staff, as regular staff meetings and training occur. However, when we have children who are late those staff have to wait with the children rather than get on with their jobs. As a consequence, pupils who are being picked up **after 3.15pm** will incur a one off late charge of £5 per child. For every 5 minutes after 3.15pm there will then be a further penalty charge for each child of £2.50.
