

## Academic year 2015/16 (till August 2016)

### Spending:

The school received a grant of £9152 for primary school sports in the academic year 2015-16. This money was used in a number of different ways to support the provision of improved quality of sports and PE for all pupils:

### Impact of primary school sports funding 2015/16:

Staff are better trained to deliver high quality PE lessons.
