# English

Reading: Children will read a range of texts to consolidate their phonic knowledge and build their fluency. They will read daily, either as a class, group, pair or individually.

Writing: Children will develop their fluency with regular dictation. They will use Little Red Riding Hood as inspiration for their own warning tale.

Spelling: Children will consolidate alternative ways to spell words with long vowel sounds.

They will also learn how root words change when suffixes are added. Begin to learn Y2 words.

## Maths

Place Value: Children will understand the value of tens and ones in number up to 100. They will partition, order and compare these numbers. Children will be counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s.

Addition and Subtraction: Children will learn addition and subtraction facts to 20 and related facts to 100.

## Science

Materials: Children will identify and compare the suitability of materials for particular uses, eg for coats in a range of different weathers. They will find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed, eg twisted, stretched and squashed.

This half term we will be learning about...

#### **PSHE**

Being Me in My World: Children will understand their rights and responsibilities for being a member of their class and school.

## Geography
