English

Reading—Children will read a range of texts such as Cinderella of the Nile whilst developing their comprehension strategies.

Group reading will take place weekly, as well as opportunities to use echo, choral, paired and whole class reading, with a focus on reading fluency.

Writing—This term, there will be a strong focus on spelling patterns, accurate letter formation and correct use of punctuation. Through our Talk 4 Writing scheme, the children will develop simple characters, setting and plot through the use of effective adjectives.

Spelling-By using Spelling Shed three times a week in class, the children will have the opportunity to use their phonics knowledge to spell more difficult words with a range of word endings.

Maths

Place Value_Children will represent, order and estimate numbers to 1000

Addition and Subtraction-Children will add and subtract 10s across, add two digit and 3 digit numbers together and complete inverse operations.

<u>Science</u>

As well as learning about the three main strands of science, the children will explore plants through their "How Does Your Garden Grow?" unit.

Year Three Curriculum

Overview Autumn I

This half term we will be learning about...

PSHE

In PSHE, we be exploring the unit Being Me in My World' will focus on making our school community a better place by identifying universal rights for children. We will link this to our school rules and values

History

In History we will focus on time periods that made prehistoric Britain. We will create times lines and place AD and BC on a timeline. We will focus on Stone, Bronze and Iron age and use archaeological evidence to identify changes happened between these periods.

DT

For DT this term, the children will look at seasonal foods and the importance of importing food depending on the time of year before designing and cooking their own seasonal tart.

PE

In autumn I, the children will be practicing their throwing, catching and shooting skills by learning the game of handball.

RE

This half term we will use the Birmingham Syllabus for RE to explore the dispositions 'Sharing and Being Generous' and 'Caring for Others,' Animals and the Environment.'

Music

This term we will be learning music through Glockenspiel. This unit children will learn about the language of music through playing the glockenspiel.

French

Children will use puppets to practice a variety of French greetings and introductions. They will choose the correct greeting based on the time of day and ask someone how they are.

French lesson and gymnastics club will take place after school. Swimming lessons for a small group of children will take place each Monday afternoon. You will receive a letter when it is your child's turn.
