English

Reading

This half term we will continue to read in groups. A new book each week helps build decoding, fluency and comprehension skills to help all children make progress through the Year I curriculum.

Writing

This half term we will focus on writing to describe and inform. We will use dictation and independent writing to create simple sentences that make sense and accurately use a capital letter and full stop. Some children may also begin to use 'and' to join their written ideas.

Spelling/Phonics

During this half term we will continue working through our FFT phonics programme. We will focus on alternative ways of making vowel sounds as well as meeting new di- and trigraphs.

<u>Maths</u>

Building on last half term, we will continue to look at addition and subtraction within 10. We will also look at 2D and 3D shapes and their properties as well as exploring patterns with these shapes.

We will continue the daily Mastering Number programme.

Science

Science for this half term is all about the human body where we will be looking at different body parts and our five senses.

Year One Curriculum

Overview Autumn I

This half term we will be learning about...

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be 'Celebrating Differences' through a respect, antibullying and being unique focus.

Geography

In Geography, we will locate features of our school on both maps and aerial photographs. We will use this knowledge to create our own maps of the classroom - locating features by considering distance and direction. We will also use the results of a survey to create our own designs to improve key areas of the playground.

Αrt

Year I will experiment with a range of mark making using a variety of colours, media and techniques. We will create drawings using observational skills and a range of lines and mark making before colouring carefully.

PΕ

During this half term we will be focussing on gymnastics. We will be learning basic skills such as jumping, rolling, balancing and travelling and using these skills to perform basic sequences.

RE

Throughout this year our class religion will be Christianity. We will explore other religions through our weekly RE lessons.

Music

Computing will be taught during the Spring term.

Computing

For this half term our computing lessons will focus on creating drawings and text files about ourselves. We will use JIT5.
