

### English

**Reading:** Children will read a range of texts whilst developing their comprehension strategies. Group reading will take place weekly, as well as opportunities to use echo, choral, paired and whole class reading, with a focus on reading fluency.

**Writing:** Children will develop their fluency with regular dictation. They will be writing to instruct by writing an instructional manual. They will focus on using prepositions effectively.

**Spelling:** By using Spelling Shed three times a week in class, the children will have the opportunity to use their phonics knowledge to spell more difficult words with a range of prefixes and suffixes.

### PE

In autumn 2, the children will take part in gymnastics sessions where they will practice movements such as rolls and balances.



### Year Three Curriculum

#### Overview Autumn 2

This half term we will be learning about...

### RE

This half term we will use the Birmingham Syllabus for RE to explore the dispositions 'Creating Unity and Harmony' and 'Participating and Willingness to Lead'.

### Maths

**Addition and Subtraction-** Children will add and subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers by exchanging from the tens and hundreds.

**Multiplication and Division-** Children will make a link between repeated addition and multiplication. They will construct fact families and use manipulatives and pictorial representation to make links between multiplication and division,

### PSHE

**Celebrating differences-** children will begin to understand the important roles and responsibilities that they have both in school and out.

### Computing

The children will use J2E to complete the unit "Organising, Creating and Presenting" where they will learn how to use text, borders and images.

### Geography

In Geography, children will be learning about volcanoes. Children will start to understand how volcanoes and earthquakes occur and explain a mix of negative and positive consequences living near a volcano.

### French

Children will describe shapes using adjectives for colour and size, whilst developing confidence through games and creating animal and Christmas artwork.

### Science

During this half term, the children will begin their 'Our Bodies' unit, learning all about food groups as well as the important jobs that our skeleton and muscles have.

### Art

This term children will look at the four rules for shading to help them blend tones smoothly. Children will explore a wide range of textures using frottage. Children will have the opportunity to generate ideas and make decisions to compose an interesting work of Art.

French lesson will take place after school. Swimming lessons for a small group of children will take place each Monday afternoon for a small group of children. You will receive a letter when it is your child's turn.
