

English

Reading & Phonics

This term we will introduce split digraphs and alternative versions of the digraphs we have learnt so far. In our reading lessons we will continue to read texts that match and stretch our ability. We will have a new book each week that will progress our decoding and comprehension skills.

Writing & Spelling

We will continue to use our phonics to support our spelling. In writing our focus will be on handwriting, capital letters and full stops.

Maths

We will continue to practise number formation, and progress our understanding of place value and addition and subtraction to numbers within 20.

We will also be completing the daily Mastering Number programme that helps us build our number fluency.

Science

Our Science topic for this term is 'Polar Adventures'. We will identify and name a variety of common animals, classify animals as carnivores, herbivores and omnivores and describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals. We will use the key vocabulary of Arctic, Antarctic, carnivore, herbivore, omnivore, flexible, waterproof and habitat.

Year One Curriculum

Overview Spring 1

This half term we will be learning...

PSHE

In PSHE, we will begin to explore our dreams and goals. We will look at how to achieve our goals as well as what to do when we face obstacles.

History

In History we will be exploring how toys have changed; making comparisons between the past and present. We will learn how to sequence artefacts from different periods of time and look at how teddy bears have changed over the last 100 years!

DT

During our design technology lessons, we will learn to describe a range of fruit and vegetables and explore where they grow. We will create a recipe and then use various pieces of equipment to prepare fruits and vegetables and make a delicious smoothie.

PE

PE this term focuses on dance. We will be learning how to move like a dancer and combine movements to form a sequence which we will then perform to our friends.

RE

Throughout this term our class religion will continue to be Christianity. We will also continue to explore other religions through our weekly RE lessons.

Music

Our music lessons will explore using high, middle and low voices as well as beginning to make, and change sound, on instruments. We will learn to identify and join in with a beat whilst listening to Latin and Blues music.

Computing

Computing will be taught during the Spring 2 term.

Year 1 will visit Forest School regularly during the Spring Term where they will learn about the plants and animals in our local environment.
