## Reception Curriculum

### Overview Spring 2

This half term we will be learning about...

## PE

This half term we will be learning ball skills. We will be continuing rolling, stopping, throwing, catching, dribbling, and kicking a ball.

Please ensure your child has a PE kit in school.

## RE

We will learn about Ramadan and Eid. We will also discuss why Christians celebrate Easter. We will also compare both of these to our learning about Diwali and Christmas.

## Music

This half term we will start every music lesson by listening to and responding to different styles of music. We will then learn to play an instrument within a song and perform as a group.

## Maths

This half term we learn what doubling means. We will explore and compare length, height and time. We explore and learn about 3D shapes and we will explore numbers 9 and 10. We will work out 1 more and 1 less upto 10, we will represent 9 and 10 in different ways and look at the composition of numbers up to 10 using numicon.

## PSHE

In our PSHE circle times we will be exploring 'Healthy Me'. We will talk about the importance of exercise and rest. We will explore healthy and un healthy foods, tooth brushing and what good hygiene looks like.

## History/Geography

In history we will be learning about the past and present. We will talk about our family trees and look at how transport has changed over time. In geography we will be going on outdoor adventures: exploring the weather and the different seasons. We will make nature catchers and Spring mandalas.

## Art/DI

In art we will be looking at 3D sculptures using playdough and clay. We will practice our fine motor skills when squeezing and pinching the clay and will also use tools such as rolling pins. We will finish our learning by making animal sculptures.

## Computing

We will use the ipads and play maths games and practise our letter formation on letter join. We will also play phonics games on the interactive whiteboard.

## Science

We will be exploring the changes that happen in the world around us and learn all about Spring. We will go on a spring walk and look for signs of new life. We will also draw a range of plants and flowers.
