English

Reading & Phonics This term we will introduce more alternative versions of the digraphs we have learnt so far, for example '-y' as in 'happy' rather than 'yoyo'. In our reading lessons we will continue to read texts that match and stretch our ability Our focus will be on fluency and comprehension and we will be expected to answer all questions in full sentences.

Writing & Spelling We will continue to use our phonics to support our spelling. In writing our focus will continue to be on handwriting, capital letters and full stops as these are the essential skills we need to master before moving to Year 2.

Maths

We will continue to practice number formation, and progress our understanding of place value and addition and subtraction of numbers. This term we will work within 50 rather than 20.

We will also be completing the daily Mastering Number programme that helps us build our number fluency.

Science

Our Science topic for this term is 'On Safari'. We will identify a variety of common mini beasts as well as classify, describe and compare them. We will use the key vocabulary of insect, vertebrate and invertebrate to help us work like a scientist.

Year One Curriculum

Overview Spring 2

This half term we will be learning...

PSHE

In PSHE, we will begin to explore how to be healthy. We will think about how to make healthy choices, stay clean, medicine safety, road safety and mental health.

Geography

Our geography work will explore what the weather is like in the U.K: looking at the countries and cities that make up the United Kingdom and keeping a daily weather record to find out more about hot and cold places in the UK.
