English

Reading: Children will read a fiction, non-fiction and poetry to consolidate their phonic knowledge and build their fluency and vocabulary. They will read daily, either as a class, group, pair or individually.

Writing: Children will develop their spelling and handwriting fluency with regular dictation. They will be writing to a story from a character's perspective. They will be focusing on using a statements, commands, questions and exclamations to interest the reader.

Spelling: Children will learn how to spell words with alternative spellings for j-g/ge/dge and s-ce/se, for example gem/lunge/bridge and dance/loose.

Maths

Multiplication and division: We will be looking at doubling and halving, odd numbers and then focusing on multiplying and dividing by 10 and 5.

Measuring - measuring, comparing and ordering in cm and m, ml and l, and g and kg. Children will use the four operations to solve measure problems.

<u>Science</u>

Mini Worlds—Biology: Children will be classifying things that are living, dead and those that have never been alive. Children will explore the habitats of some plants and animals. Children will be able to describe a simple food chain.
