

## English

### Reading & Phonics

This term we are looking at tri-graphs and alternative versions of common sounds. We will continue to read in groups and will have a new book each week that will help us make progress with our reading skills.

### Writing & Spelling

Our writing focus for this half term will be writing instructions and adding in detail with carefully chosen adjectives. We will continue to focus on handwriting, punctuation and grammar skills.

## Maths

We will introduce the children to multiplication and division using 2s, 5s and 10s. We will use songs that the children can share with you at home to encourage them to practise independently. We will also look at place value between 50 and 100, counting forwards and backwards and partitioning numbers.

## Science

This half term we will be identifying and describing the structure of plants. We will look at the difference between wild plants and garden plants and go on a flower hunt around school to help us build on work done in forest school and begin to name plants and trees.

## Year One Curriculum

### Overview Summer 1

This half term we will be learning about...

## PSHE

In PSHE, we will look at the topic of relationships including families and friendships.

## History

Our history work will focus on 'How explorers have changed our world'. We will be learning about several famous explorers throughout history and the significance and impact they have had on events and peoples' ideas. We will sequence photographs on a timeline and use this to retell a story from the past.

## Design Technology

Our DT work will develop skills joining fabrics; using pins, staples and/or glue. We will design a puppet from a traditional tale and create a hand puppet using a preferred join before decorating to match our initial design.

## PE

This half term focuses on invasion games where the children are challenged to pass a ball using their hands (chest pass and bounce pass), and different parts of their feet.

## RE

Throughout this year our class religion will be Christianity. We will explore other religions through our weekly RE lessons.

## Music

During our music lessons, we will be learning to sing in unison and practicing new songs to perform in our year group's assembly. We will also be using our bodies to make sounds: clapping, stomping and tapping to a beat.

## Computing

Computing will be continued to be taught in the second half of the Summer term.

Year 1 will continue to visit Forest School regularly during the Summer Term where they will learn about our local environment.
