Writing & Spelling - Our writing this half term will focus on bringing together everything we have learnt so far in Year 1. We aim to be able to write a simple sentence that makes sense, use capital letters, full stops, question marks or exclamation marks in the correct places, use correctly formed letters that sit accurately on the line and demonstrate that we can spell using phonics.

Phonics and Reading - Children will complete our phonics programme and continue to build fluency, pace and expression when reading texts. We will also complete the Phonics Screening Check.

Year One Curriculum

Overview Summer 2

This half term we will be learning about...

PE

This half term focuses on athletics where the children will develop skills such as running at different speeds, changing direction, throwing and jumping.

RE

Throughout this year our class religion will be Christianity. We will explore other religions through our weekly RE lessons.

Maths

During Maths this half term, we will begin learning about fractions. Children will learn how to recognise and find a half and a quarter of an object, shape or quantity. We will also learn about money and how to recognise coins and notes as well as counting coins. Finally, we will learn how to tell the time using the vocabulary of o'clock and half past. We will also be completing the daily Mastering Number programme.

PSHE

Changing Me: Children will learn about life cycles in nature, human life stages, and the correct terminology for body parts.

Geography

During Geography this term, we will explore and compare the UK and Asia. We will learn about human and physical features, draw sketch maps and continue to use directional language. We will focus specifically on Shanghai, China and then compare the geographical features to those in our local area.

Music

We will be continuing to develop our singing in unison skills through regular music assemblies and class singing.

Computing

Our computing sessions will focus on using and writing simple algorithms to provide instructions for digital devices. We will then create our own basic programmes to control robotic equipment such as the BeeBots.

Science

This half term we will continue to learn about the difference between wild plants and garden plants as well as naming plants and trees. We will also be working scientifically, investigating light sources and shadows.

Art

Our Art lessons will introduce the children to paper-based 3D art forms, focusing on techniques like rolling paper tubes, shaping paper strips, and constructing imaginative sculptures.

Year 1 will continue to visit Forest School regularly during the Summer Term where they will learn about our local environment.
