READING BOOKS (From October)

Children will be given reading books for them to read to you every **FRIDAY**. Reading books need to be returned to school on the following **WEDNESDAY** so that they can be changed. Please listen to your child read their book as many times as possible in a week and write a comment in their reading record book so we know that they have read at home with you. Children will start with books with no words, please encourage your child to tell the story using the pictures.

HOME LEARNING (From October)

We will send Phonic phoneme frames for you to use with your child at home, to help them with their phonics, reading and writing. We will show you how to use these and your children will use them in their phonics lessons too. We use the letter join website in class to support letter formation, we will send home the log in details. Throughout the year we will set different home learning projects that your child can complete in the holidays. In the Summer term, children in Reception can complete the Summer Reading Challenge.

PE

Reception will have PE on a **FRIDAY**.

PE will start the week beginning: 12.09.2025. PE lessons will mostly be outdoors so children need a white t-shirt, plain navy or black shorts/joggers, trainers/pumps. Please ensure your child has their kit in a bag with all items clearly named including pumps/trainers.
