Computing- Emails and messaging

Understand the basic workings of computer networks including the internet. Understand the importance of using technology safely, respectfully and responsibly.

Science-Earth and space

Year 5 learn about the geocentric and heliocentric models and discover that planets, moons, and stars are spherical. They explore how celestial bodies orbit because of gravity, including the Moon's orbit and its phases. They learn that day and night happen as the Earth spins, and the seasons change because the Earth is tilted. They also find out how a sundial uses the Sun's shadow to show the time, and they learn about the uses of satellites and why space junk can be a danger to them.

Art- Space imagery

To explore the purpose and effect of imagery. To understand and explore decision making in creative processes. To develop drawn ideas through printmaking.

French – Shopping in France

Correctly build and pronounce two-digit numbers that have been generated randomly. Recall vocabulary by matching the correct pictures to the appropriate words.
